### **NEW School Uniform Changes**

Issues raised included the different uniforms worn by EYs, KS1 and KS2 children.

Concerns about the current KS2 uniform (shirt, tie and jumper).

See summary of the council meeting minutes below.

*“Outcome of yesterday’s School Council meeting about our school uniform:*

- *We want the whole school to wear the same uniform*
- *None of the children like the jumpers – they are itchy*
- *None of the children like the ties – they are hot, tight and difficult to tie*
- *We want polo shirts for all children and sweatshirts for all children just like in Key Stage 1”*

**IMPORTANT Note to parents:** There will be no changes before September 2019.

Changes can be phased in across 2019-2020 as needed.

The uniform for all children will be:

- **Blue Sweatshirt/Cardigan with school logo**
- **White polo shirt with school logo**
- **Grey trousers/skirt/pinafore dress**
- **Plain black shoes**
- **Plain dark blue/black Hijab if appropriate**

**Uniform for summer and for PE will remain the same. For further details see the school website.**
